She was inspired to make this substantial bangle, named Sandy, after seeing an ancient Egyptian bracelet in the Metropolitan Museum of Art, so it is timeless indeed! It is made from very heavy solid sterling wire, with overlapping ends and a hammered surface. Like all her bangles, Celeste makes it in five sizes.
