Lariat necklaces are so easy and comfortable to wear. All you have to do is to slip one end through the other and bring the pendant up to your neck. That's it. They are stylish as well, with part of the necklace around the neck, and the rest dangling below. All of Celeste's designs are made from high quality solid sterling silver made here in the U.S. She names each of her designs for the first woman who wears it. The lariat you see here features Celeste's signature square wire chain and is named Jaclyn, named for the woman who bought the first of this design in Richmond, Virginia.
