Visiting Artist for April: Weaver Margaret Cherre



We are so pleased to welcome a weaver to our cooperative as a Visiting Artist for the month of April. Margaret Cherre has worked with fiber all her life, learning to knit as a child, and progressing through sewing, crochet, embroidery, macramé, and other fiber-related skills. She used these skills to dress her family and herself, decorate her home, and to make gifts for friends and family. In 2007, Margaret stumbled into a weaving class, and by the end of the six sessions, she was hooked. She weaves on vintage looms that she lovingly restores to working order. Her work is recognized for the variety of fibers, colors, and weaving patterns. Achieving a soft fabric that drapes well is important to her, so she uses fine gauge fibers, most commonly silk, rayon and fine gauge cotton. She is also now doing some hand painting of her work, which

ensures that her pieces are unique.
