

The Road to the 2019 USASF World Cheerleading Championship



Worlds Bid Declaration

The OCF will offer 1 Partial Paid Bid of \$5000 CDN payable directly to the IASF upon registration and 3 At Large Bids.

Bid Process:

The Partial Paid bid will be awarded to the highest score in the bid qualifying divisions. Each program is only eligible for up to 2 bids. Bids will be awarded based on top scores with at least one bid being awarded in each of Level 5 and Level 6.

At least one bid will be awarded to an Ontario based team assuming it achieves the highest standards established by other bid winners within the competition.

If there is a tie, the Ontario Cheerleading Federation will grant the bid to the team who scores highest on their second run

At Large bids will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Scores (when comparable across divisions)
- Judges' recommendation

The Ontario Cheerleading Federation does not guarantee At-Large bids to the highest scoring teams. We will attempt to follow the natural progression in scores, but please note that scoring discrepancies may require other criteria to be considered when awarding At-Large bids.

In the event that a team awarded a bid declines the bid at this competition, the OCF can at its discretion present that opportunity to another worthy participating team.

Due to the addition of the Non-Tumbling and Global Club categories at the 2019 IASF Worlds, the OCF will award one At Large Cheer Bid as long as there are entries in these categories.

Weighting of Runs:

The first run will comprise 50% of the final score. The second run will be worth 50% of the final score.

Scoring Process:

IASF Divisions will be scored on the IASF weighted Varsity All Star Score System. USASF Divisions will be scored on the standard Varsity All Star Score System.

Eligibility:

Proof of age (government issued photo id) will be required for all World's Bid athletes.

Please be familiar with the IASF and USASF eligibility applicable to your division. Teams with ineligible athletes; any athlete not verified through the Age Eligibility Worlds Check in process may be declared ineligible. (Please remember that this must be completed prior to your first competition run).
