College Admissions Process

#CAP is a new program of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.

It is a step-by-step approach (STEPP) that will help high school seniors effectively and efficiently navigate the college enrollment process at any college or university — HBCUs and non-HBCUs. STEPP will include locating scholarships and other financial aid, helping students with ACT and SAT preparation and fees, and ensuring that students compile a portfolio of information regarding the colleges to which they have applied along with the results obtained. There will be several opportunities for juniors to get a head start on the application and enrollment process.

WHAT WILL WE DO?

S — **Search**: Search for schools and scholarships that meet your needs.

T - Test: Prepare and take the required admissions test(s).

E — **Evaluate:** What schools are on your short list.

P — Punctuality: Create a time-line to include completing and submitting applications, essays, financial aid forms, and other required materials to ensure no important deadlines are missed.
