### **OCTOBER 29: THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME** Ex 22:20-26/1 Thes 1:5c-10/Mt 22:34-40

The greatest commandment is two-fold: Love God with all your heart, soul and mind and love your neighbor as yourself. It is simple in theory, but can be oh, so difficult to actually put into practice. Yes, Lord, I want to worship you, but I would rather not deal with that annoving and tiresome neighbor. Or perhaps we get a lot of pleasure and reward from helping our neighbors, but we never see the image of Christ in them or think about how God loves them. This also has a great impact on evangelization. We are called to invite others to meet Christ, but how can we do that unless we first have a relationship with Jesus ourselves. How can others trust us enough to accept the invitation, unless they know that they are loved? To integrate the love of God and love or neighbor takes practice. Perhaps today, pray for someone whom you find difficult to love.




