



### Copycat Macaroni Grill's Penne Rustica

Gratinata sauce:

1 teaspoon butter

1 teaspoon chopped garlic

1/2 teaspoon Dijon mustard

1/2 teaspoon dill

1/2 teaspoon chopped rose-

1/2 cup marsala cooking wine

1/8 teaspoon cayenne pepper 4 cups heavy cream

Penne Rustica:

1/2 ounce pancetta or bacon (I used an ounce which was 1 strip of bacon for me)

9 raw shrimp, peeled and deveined

6 ounces grilled chicken breasts, sliced (1 large breast or 2 small)

8-12 ounces penne pasta, cooked

3 Tablespoons butter

1/2 teaspoon chopped shallot

pinch salt and pepper

1/2 cup parmesan cheese

1/4 teaspoon paprika

(optional) 3 sprigs fresh rosemary (for garnish)

For Gratinata Sauce: Saute butter, garlic, and rosemary until garlic begins to brown. Add Marsala wine and reduce by one-third. Add remaining ingredients, reduce by half of the original volume. Set aside. For Penne Rustica: Saute pancetta or bacon until it begins to brown. Add butter, shallots, and shrimp. Cook until shrimp are evenly pink but still translucent. Add chicken, salt, pepper, and mix thoroughly. Add gratinata sauce and 1/4 cup parmesan cheese. Simmer until sauce thickens. In a large bowl, combine shrimp and chicken mixture with the cooked pasta. Pour into a large casserole dish or roaster. Sprinkle with 1/4 cup more parmesan cheese and sprinkle with paprika. Bake at 475 degrees for 10 to 15 minutes. Remove and garnish with fresh rosemary sprig.

We are all invited to the banquet, but do we accept the invitation? Jesus is speaking about the Kingdom of God in today's parable, but in a similar way, it also applies to Mass. Look at the excuses people in the parable give for not attending the celebration: they are too busy with their own plans to be interrupted by this generous invitation to the banquet. How often do we look at Mass as a burden or see it as an interruption of our other scheduled events - sporting events, chores that need to be done around the house or even work that we need to finish up - almost as if we are saying to God: "I will show up if it is convenient or if I have nothing better to do..." Even if we do show up for Mass, are we fully present? Or are we like the guest who came without a wedding garment? Do we spend that hour giving God the worship he is due by our active participation at Mass, or are we planning the rest of our day, thinking about our to-do lists?


