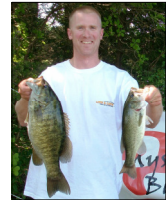

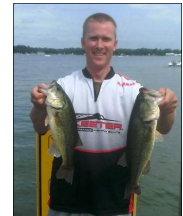
Additional Tournament Success

July 20: After opening the season on three Indiana lakes, I expected a let down in attendance at Randall Lake in Michigan. Boy, was I wrong! Forty-four teams came out to compete. As a director, my proudest moment came afterward during the weigh in. The event was held at a public campground and many children came to watch. Our members set an excellent example! They talked with and even handed their fish off for the children to hold. We emphasize sportsmanship at each tournament, and it was on display this day.

August 17: Forty seven teams drove to Kalamazoo, Michigan. Our average of 46 teams per event, and over 1,500 hits on my website illustrates how much impact the circuit has on the Michiana fishing community.

September 7: This was my favorite R & B tournament, because I won! With the workload of running the circuit, I never expect myself to win, so this was special victory. After 45 teams came to our finale, we finished averaging 46.2 teams per event with a total of 132 members.
