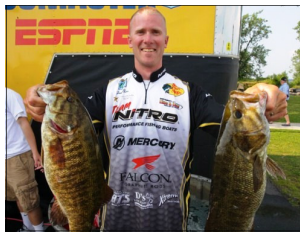
Public Appearances

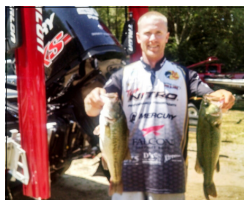
Additional Tournament Success
