

Welcome Our Guest Speaker **Don Dare**

Since August 1996, Don Dare has been the 6 On Your Side consumer reporter at WATE-TV, Knoxville. He and his wife, Lynn, met at North Carolina Wesleyan College back in the 1960's. He is a 1968 graduate and she graduated two years later in 1970. They have one son, Brent, and have been married since December 1969.

A year before their marriage, Don volunteered and joined the US Army. He went through Infantry Officer Candidate School was commissioned a 2^{nd} Lieutenant. At Ft Gordon, Georgia, he completed Signal Officer Basic training and was later assigned to the Television Division at the Southeastern Signal School. In the fall of 1971, as 1^{st} Lieutenant he went to Vietnam where he served in Saigon with AFVN, American Forces Radio and TV Vietnam. Yes – "G-o-o-d Morning Vietnam."

After leaving the Army, Don went to graduate school at the University of Georgia where he earned a Master's Degree in Journalism.
