1. GENERAL SHOW RULES

a. SEQAC show will be run under AQHA, PHAA and AAA Ltd Rules as applicable.

b. No alcohol is allowed in, or can be consumed in the marshalling areas, working arenas or show pen/contest areas.

c. Animal Welfare

i. Abuse or mistreatment of any horse, in any manner, will not be tolerated at SEQAC shows and will be severely dealt with and

relevant Associations notified.

ii. Competitor's/participants at any event run by SEQAC have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion.

d. Code of Conduct

i. Abuse or mistreatment of any horse, in any manner, will not be tolerated at SEQAC shows and will be severely dealt with and relevant Associations notified.

ii. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Club and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of the AAA, SEQAC, PHAA and the AQHA at all times. Competitors/ participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.

iii. Abuse of Judges, Stewards or workers at SEQAC shows will not be tolerated and will be severely dealt with and relevant Associations notified.

e. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.

f. NO DOGS AT ALL ON GROUNDS. (Showground Rules)

2. RIGHT OF CHANGE

a. The Show Committee reserves the right to alter the program and/or order of events.

b. SEQAC reserves the right at the Committee's discretion to combine classes with insufficient numbers.

3. ELIGIBILITY FOR ENTRY

a. Entries will only be accepted from Members or upon payment of Temporary Day Membership fee.

b. Horses must be registered with the AAA, PHAA and AQHA for designated Appaloosa, Quarter Horse or Paint / Paint Bred breed classes. Production of registration cards may be required and all horse's registration number must be included on entry form. Failure to include numbers will result in points not being recorded.
c. Exhibitors must be current financial members of the AQHA, PHAA or AAA to show in any breed class. Production of membership cards may be required and membership number must

be included on entry form. Failure to include numbers will result in points not being recorded.

d. Amateur Exhibitors must be current financial Amateur members of the AQHA, PHAA or AAA to show in Amateur classes. Production of membership cards may be required and membership number must be included on entry form. Failure to include numbers will result in points not being recorded.

4. SHOW RULES

a. Open Jackpot Halter classes will be judged prior to Halter classes. Any Supreme of Breed will be judged at the completion of each Breeds Halter Classes.

b. A 2 Year Old horse may only enter a maximum of Five (5) Ridden Events per day. A 2 Year Old horse entering a Junior Horse event cannot enter a 2 Year Old event (for example, a 2 Year Old entering the Junior Horse Trail cannot then enter the 2 Year Old Trail and Vice Versa).

c. SEQAC may at some shows engage a second Judge to Judge Trail classes and times for the trail will be announced at each show.

5. PROTESTS

a. Protests must be lodged within one (1) hour of the completion of the event or class and must be accompanied by \$50.00, which is refundable if the Protest is upheld. Only Competitors or Exhibitors in the disputed class or any Show Official may lodge a Protest.
b. All Protests will be adjudicated by the Disputes Committee, which will be made up of one (1) Committee Member, the Show Manager and one (1) Competitor.

6. STABLES AND CAMPING

a. Stables are available for an additional fee. Stable will not be unlocked until paid for. A stable cleaning deposit of \$20 is payable for a day show and \$40 if staying overnight or longer and will only be refunded when stable checked as clean.

b. Powered and non-powered Camping is also available at the grounds for a fee.

7. VERSATILITY EVENTS


a. To be eligible for the Versatility horses MUST enter in all 4 Classes (Versatility Halter, Lungeline, Hunter in Hand, Led Trail), compete in a minimum of two (2) events and pay an additional \$10 entry fee.

b. Any horses entered in the Versatility classes cannot be ridden in any class at the show.

c. All Yearling and 2YO Versatility Events will be judged and all competitors will be placed in each class. All Versatility entrants will be scored pursuant to AAA High Point Rules.

d. Any horse entered in the Yearling or 2yo Versatility is not eligible for the Open Versatility.

e. Final overall Versatility placings will be awarded at the end of the show.
