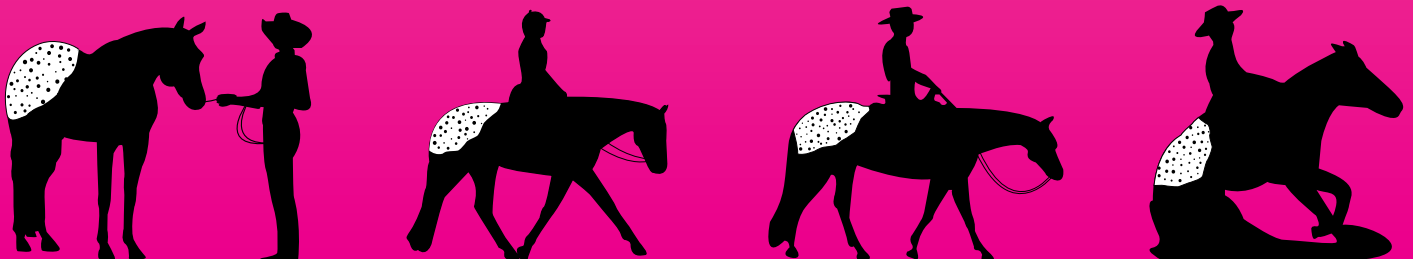

Trisha Shorten Armstrong

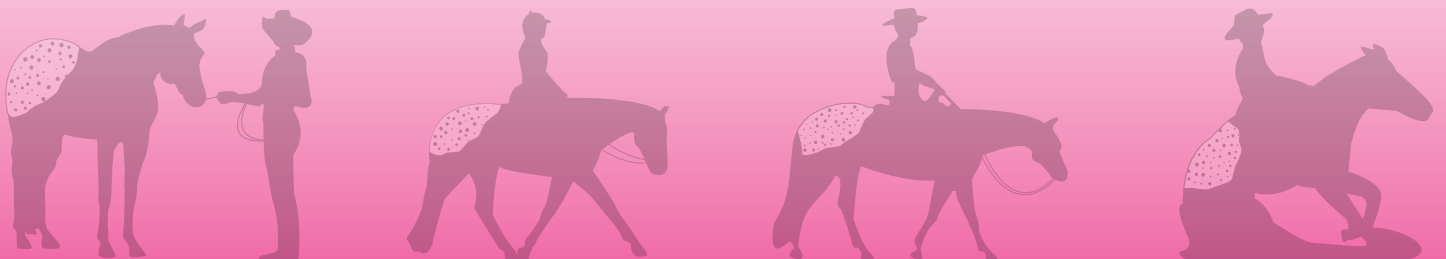

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RULES & REGULATIONS

Classes with a # indicate versatility classes.

1. GENERAL SHOW RULES:

a) The QLD State Appaloosa Championships will be run under AAA Ltd, HSAA and AQHA Rules, as applicable.

b) No Member will attend a show or event under the influence of alcohol or drugs and behave so as to bring the Association into disrepute or endanger themselves, any competitor, show official or member of the public.

c) A member will always conduct themselves in a sportsman like manner and obey all instructions and directions given by any show official or judge. Abuse of Judges, Stewards or workers at this show will not be tolerated and will be severely dealt with.

d) Animal Welfare:

i. No Person may treat a horse, including breeds other than Appaloosas, in a manner considered to be inhumane.

ii. This prohibition against cruelty includes, but is not limited to, AAA member and/or owners of Appaloosas, their agents, representatives, and employees, the actions for which a member or owner are also responsible.

iii. For violation of the AAA Ltd Animal Welfare Rule, a AAA Member may be disciplined, suspended, fined and/or expelled from the Association.

e) Smoking is not permitted in the Stables or within 10 meters of the Canteen or Arenas.

f) Only Strappers, Riders/Handlers will be permitted in the Marshalling Arena during the Show.

g) It is Mandatory for all Youth to wear a Safety Helmet, of approved Australian Standard, and appropriate riding boots to be worn at all times, except when marshalling or competing in Western events when a youth has the option to wear a western hat.

h) Youth are NOT permitted to handle/ride/exhibit colts/stallions at any AAA Ltd Approved show. This rule will be strictly enforced.

2. BIOSECURITY:

a) Biosecurity measures will be implemented in the case of a suspected and/or confirmed case of any notifiable disease. Should Biosecurity be implemented the owner is totally responsible for all care of their livestock during any lockdown.

3. RIGHT OF CHANGE:

a) The Show Committee reserves the right to alter the program and/or order of events.

4. DRUG TESTING:

a) The Show Committee reserves the right to carry out Drug Testing at its discretion.

5. PHOTOGRAPHY:

a) All exhibitors are required to cooperate with the Official Photographer.

b) All winners must have their photos taken by the Official Photographer in the designated area.

c) The Official Photographer will be under the direction of Show Management and any photos taken may be used at the discretion of the Association for promotional purposes This will also include exhibitor's cooperation for Sponsors Requirements.

d) Refusal to comply may result in forfeiture of any prize money.

6. ELIGIBILITY FOR ENTRY

a) All horses must be registered with the Australian Appaloosa Association Ltd, in the appropriate registry, to be eligible to be shown.

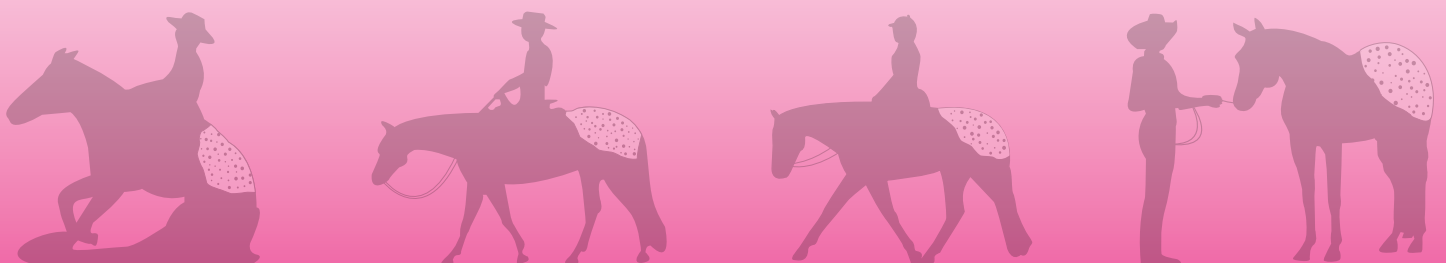
b). All Owners/Competitors/Strappers/Riders and/or Handlers must be current financial members of the AAA Ltd to compete at the State Show.

7. PROTESTS

a) Protests must be lodged within one (1) hour of the completion of the event or class and must be accompanied by \$50.00 cash payment, which is refundable if the Protest is upheld.

b) Only Competitors or Exhibitors in the disputed class or any Show Official may lodge a Protest.

c) All Protests will be adjudicated by the Disputes Committee, which will be made up of one (1) Committee Member, the Show Manager and one (1) Competitor.



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8. PRIZEMONEY

a) Futurity Event prizemoney will be paid by cheque 21 days after the completion of the Show.

9. STABLING/CAMPING/PARKING

a) Competitors will be allowed to enter Burpengary Equestrian Centre (BEC) from 7am Friday 17th June 2016. Entry is not permitted prior to this date.

b) Stable number(s) will be on the end of each stable blocks. Stables will have some sawdust already in them. You are able to bring your own pre packed shavings. Additional sawdust may be available.

c) Camping – Trailers, vehicles, etc. must park at the direction of Show Staff and so as to not inhibit other competitors access.

d) HORSES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE CAMPING AREAS.

e) Stable Cleaning – Cleaning fee is only refunded if your stable is cleaned and inspected at your departure by a designated Committee member. Once inspected your Stable will be locked.

f) Marshalling Areas – All outdoor arenas are designated Marshalling Areas, and may be utilised at any time by the Show Committee.

g) Temporary structures including, but not limited to, make shift yards, electric fences, etc. are not permitted at BEC.

h) NO DOGS AT ALL. (Council and Showground Rules)

i) NO Bikes, Skateboards, Scooters, etc. are permitted within the Stable or Arena areas.

j) Appropriate clothing and foot wear must be worn at all times when in the Stable or Arena areas.

10. ENTRIES

a) Entries and full payment MUST be received by Monday 10th June 2016.

b) Extra entries will only be accepted from horses entered by the closing date and must be submitted and paid in full at the Show Office no later than 3pm Sunday 19th June 2016. Double Fees will apply.

11. REFUNDS

a) Office and Program Fees are NON REFUNDABLE.

b) On or Before Closing Date – Class Entry Fees MAY be refunded upon Death or Injury of a horse, less 25% of the Entry Fees. Written requests MUST be accompanied by a Veterinarian Certificate and must be received by 5.00pm on the closing date. NO EXCEPTIONS.

c) After the Closing Date – Class Entry fees MAY be refunded upon Death of a horse ONLY, less 25% of the Entry Fees. Written Requests MUST be accompanied by a Veterinarian Certificate and must be received 24hrs prior to the start of the Show. NO EXCEPTIONS.

d) Written requests and Veterinarian Certificates will be tabled at the next Committee Meeting after the Show.

12. 2 & 3 YEAR OLD HORSES

a) A 2yo horse may only enter a maximum of Five (5) Ridden Events per day.

b) A 2yo horse that is competing in the 2yo Led Versatility Events cannot enter any ridden Event at this show. The same applies for 3yo & over Led Versatility Events.

c) A 2yo horse competing in Ridden events is not eligible to enter any 2yo Led Versatility Events at this show. Junior and Senior Ridden horses can not enter the 3yo & over Led Versatility Events.

d) A 2yo or 3yo horse entering a Junior Horse event cannot enter a 2yo or 3yo event. E.g. A 3yo entering the Junior Horse Trail cannot enter the 3yo Trail and Vice Versa.

e) 3yo and over Led Versatility classes are non-point scoring events.

13. SUBSTITUTION OF HORSES

a) Should an entered horse be vetted out, it shall remain ineligible for further competition for the duration of the Show.

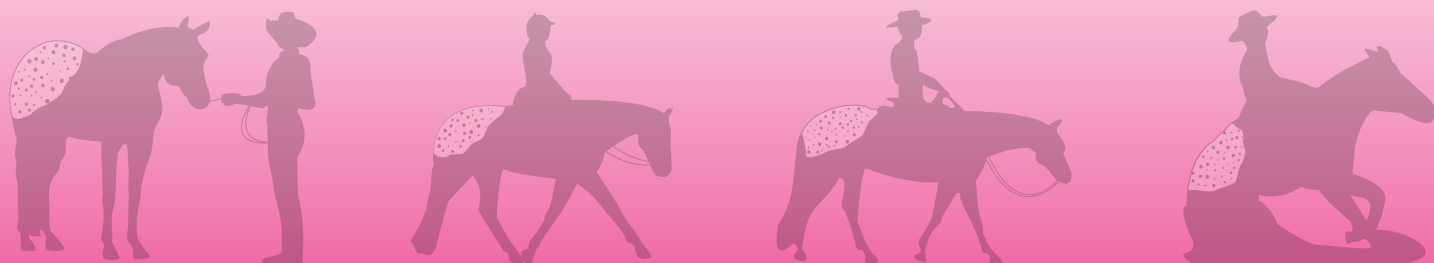
b) YOUTH – If a Ridden horse (including Showmanship) is vetted out, and it had been entered for competition in a Youth Event, then that Youth can use a replacement Ridden horse so long as the replacement ridden horse has been previously entered in the Show.

c) AMATEUR – If an Amateurs Ridden horse (including Showmanship) is vetted out, they will be permitted to use a replacement ridden horse so long as the replacement ridden horse has been previously entered in the Show. The replacement ridden horse must be Owned/Leased by the Amateur or their Immediate Family as per the AAA Ltd Rules.

d) An Amateur Junior horse cannot replace an Amateur Senior Horse and Vice Versa.

e) A Horse competing in Halter that has been vetted out cannot be replaced in that halter event by another horse.

f) All horse substitutions, as set out above, must be made to the Show Office no later than 1 hour prior to the commencement of the respective class.



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14. EVENTS, ATTIRE & TACK APPOINTMENTS

- a) Any Competitor/Horse NOT wearing the approved Attire/Tack will be refused entry to the class.
- b) All Events/Attire/Tack as run under respective AAA, HSAA and EA rules as applicable.
- c) Dressage horses can compete in two consecutive levels E.g. Preliminary/Novice Horses maybe ridden in dressage classes by one rider and then ridden by Youth/Amateur in their classes.
- d) Suitability for Dressage and Led Hack: A competitor may show more than one horse in this event. In this case, all horses must have a handler dressed in appropriate show attire.
- e) Most Colourful Appaloosa: No B BT or BR horses in this event - It will be judged 60% colour, 40% confirmation, action, substance, quality & manners.
- f) Leadline; Youth competing in this event cannot compete in any other ridden event.
- g) Youth Walk/Trot 13 & Under; Youth competing in these events cannot compete in any other ridden events.
- h) Appaloosa Limited Amateur competitors can enter Limited Amateur as well as other Amateur classes and open events. Ltd Hi Point only includes LTD classes.
- i) A Limited Amateur is not eligible to compete in any feature (Amateur or Open) performance events (including showmanship) at any breed show including Appaloosa.
- j) Appaloosa Amateur Masters can enter the Masters, other Amateur Classes and open events. Masters Hi Point only includes Masters Classes.

k) Weanlings: Must be weaned and a minimum of 18 weeks of age prior to the beginning of the event.

l) Yearling Versatility: must enter a min of 4 of the 6 classes to be eligible for the versatility award. All Yearling Versatility Events will be judged and all competitors will be placed. All Versatility entrants will be scored pursuant to AAA High Point Rules.

m) 2yr old Led Versatility: must enter a min of 4 of the 6 classes to be eligible for the versatility award. All 2yo Versatility Events will be judged and all competitors will be placed. All Versatility entrants will be scored pursuant to AAA High Point Rules.

n) Exhibitors Pair - All horses must be Owned/Leased, by Association's Records, and Shown at this Show by the Exhibitor.

15. HIGH POINT AWARDS

a) All High Points will be calculated on the 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 System. Tie Breakers will be as per the AAA Ltd. Rule Book.

b) Any Youth or Amateur who is competing on more than one (1) horse in Events, may nominate a maximum of two (2) horses whose points will be counted towards their High Point Award of the Show. Only the Highest Placing from Events will count towards High Point Awards.

c) Nominations must be made prior to the commencement of the show with the Show Secretary.

16. RANCH RIDING / WESTERN PLEASURE CLASSES

No horse can cross enter, a western pleasure and ranch riding class at the same show regardless of division (youth, amateur, or open).

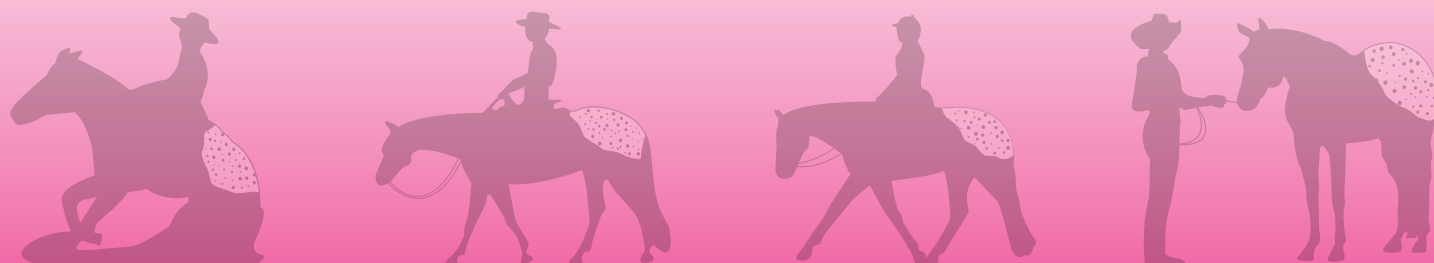
