### Rider Achievement Awards & Requirements

- Scores may be earned in any year, but before October 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.
- Rider must not have won an Achievement Award at this level previously.
- Rider must be a member in good standing at the time the scores are earned.
- Awards are based on the average of scores awarded to Jr/YR, Adult Amateur, and Open divisions at each level for Recognized and schooling shows. Horse and rider may only receive one award per year at the highest level for which they qualify.
- The [Rider Achievement Award Reporting Form](#) must be submitted by October 1st of the current year to the Awards Coordinator. Please submit copies of the front page of the dressage tests with your forms. Submitting scores and required documentation from all shows is the member's responsibility. Incomplete forms will not be processed.
