



Chaperon Training

1. Student contract

- a. Chaperons and student leaders will hold students accountable to the contract.
- b. If the contract is breached, students are given the opportunity to repent and show extraordinary behavior to stay at the dance.
- c. Otherwise, they will be asked to leave and/or escorted out.

2. Parent contact*

Policy in place for violent, suspicious or harmful activity:

Students have 5 minutes to make contact with a parent/guardian who will remove them from the facility within 30 minutes.

3. Police*

Authorities will be contacted if parent/guardians are not contacted or cannot be reached by the time 5 minutes has expired.

5. Prayer

6. Music

The DJ will give the group an explanation of our music choices, and answer any questions.

7. Video & Attire

- a. A link to a graphic video of bump & grind dancing by students has been sent to the chaperons to help them understand the nature of our concern and the behaviors for which they should watch.
- b. Discussion about the steps of our response to such dancing and attire will take place at the training meeting before the dance.

8. Please take the time to review the building’s emergency exit procedures and be sure to remain calm in case of emergency.
