Chili Cook-Off Rules

Cooking Begins at 9a; Judging at 11:00a

Entry Deadline: Saturday, October 21

COST: \$25 Entry Fee

PRIZES: Cash prizes will be awarded to the Top 3 contestants.

LOGISTICS: Each contestant will be given one labeled bowl/cup for Judging. The bowl/cup must be filled with the contestants chili and supplied to the judges for tasting.

CHECK-IN: Begins at 8:30 am. All contestants must check-in before 9:00 am for both pre-made and on-site cooking. Please drop off supplies at your space and move your vehicle immediately to allow other contestants and vendors the opportunity to unpack. Judges reserve the right to allow last minute entries into the cook-off.

REQUIREMENTS:

Contestants **MUST** bring all cooking materials, ingredients, condiments, tent, tables and table coverings. Please note that you must have a way to keep your chili warm.

Unheated city water will be available on-site.

Contestants must provide **ONE GALLON** of chili, pre-made or made on site. Please note if you will be cooking on site to provide that on your entry form. If possible, bring gas heat as electricity will be limited.

Ingredients MUST be listed for allergy purposes. These may be handwritten or typed-but must be legible.

Any type of chili will be accepted. This includes, but is not limited to, white chili, chili mac, beanless chili, chili with noodles, etc.

JUDGING WILL BEGIN AT 11:00 PM

Chili may be sold at \$1 per bowl to the public immediately following the judging with proceeds going to the contestant who made that chili. It is recommended that if you are selling to make more than one gallon.

Bowls, spoons and napkins will be provided. Contestant must provide any condiments. Chili may also be donated to the event.
