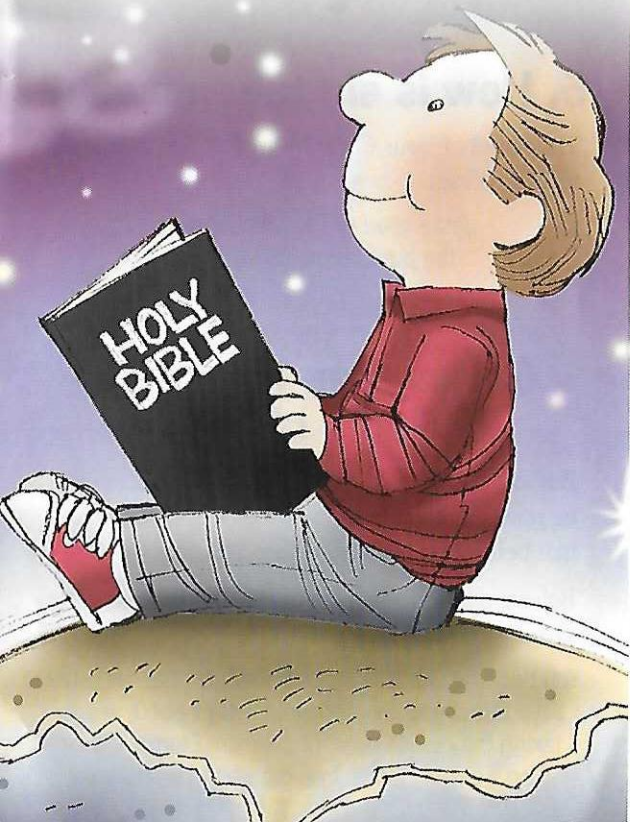


7. How can I know that I have eternal life?

you asked Jesus to be your Savior!

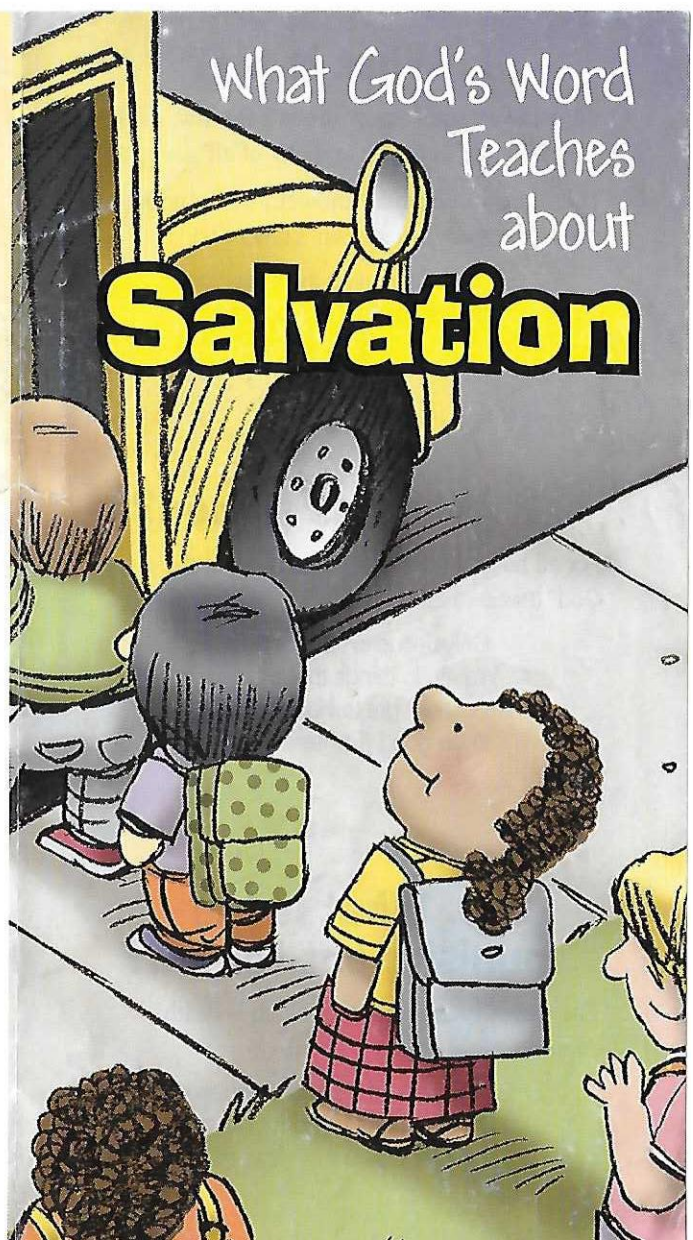

1. What is sin?

“Whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all” (James 2:10).

“Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin” (James 4:17).

Sin is anything you think, say, or do that is not right in God’s sight.

2. Who has sinned?

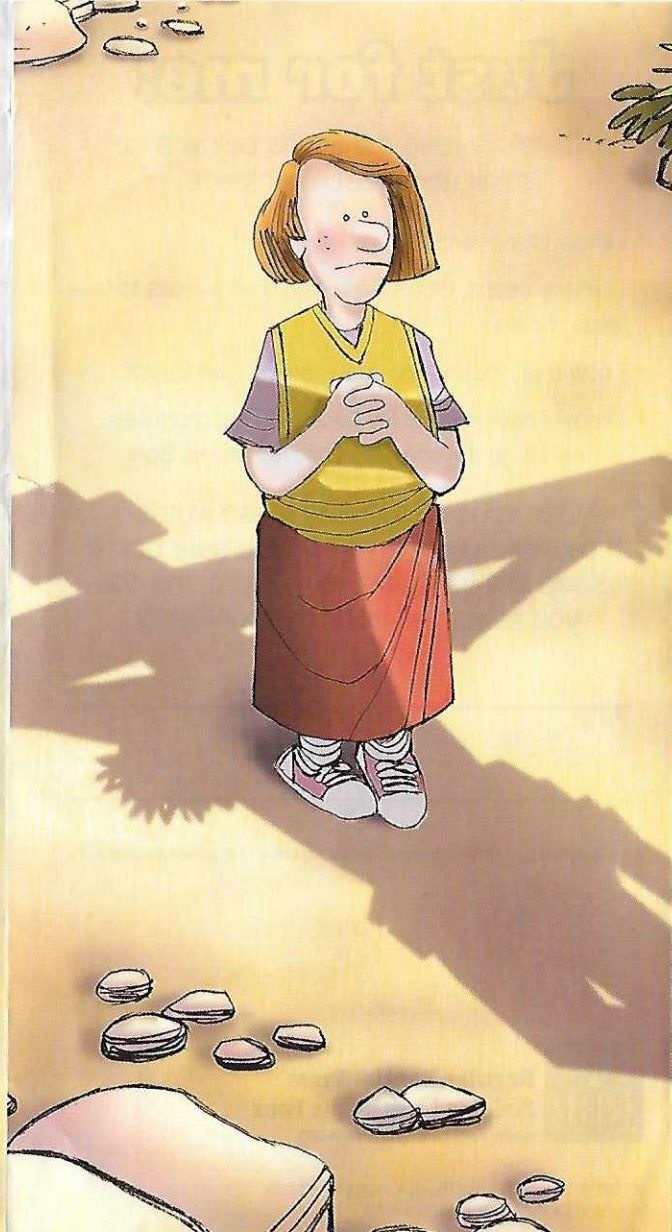
“For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God” (Romans 3:23).

Only Jesus lived a perfect life.
We all do things that are wrong.
We cannot get to Heaven by trying to be good (Ephesians 2:8, 9).

3. What is the punishment for sin?

“The wages [what is earned] of sin is death” (Romans 6:23).

God is perfect. He must punish sin.
Sin separates us from God and keeps us out of Heaven.



4. How do I know God loves me?

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life” (John 3:16).

You can put your name in place of “the world” and “whosoever.” God loves you so much He sent His Son to die for you.

5. How is sin taken away?

“The blood of Jesus Christ his [God’s] Son cleanseth us from all sin” (1 John 1:7).

Jesus died on the cross to take the punishment for your sin.

6. How can I become God’s child?

“But as many as received him [Jesus], to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name” (John 1:12).

“Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved” (Acts 16:31).

You become God’s child by believing what the Bible says about your sin and what it says about Jesus taking the punishment for your sin. Eternal life as God’s child is God’s free gift when you believe.
