- If interested, please contact u for a detailed job description.


Volunteer Openings

Current Needs

This ministry functions 100% on donations from folks just like you—both financially and materially. We have a Resource Area with gently used clothing for children (up to size 6) and maternity clothing. This area also has gently used items such as crib sheets, diaper bags, socks, shoes, etc.

We also have a Baby Boutique area where we have items our clients can shop through and use their "points" they have earned by attending our parenting classes. We reserve this area for new items such as diapers, wipes, formula, baby food, new clothing, new shoes, personal care items (shampoo, etc)

Here is a list of some of our current needs:

- Adult shampoo & conditioner (we are ok on baby wash right now)
- ♦ Diapers sizes 5 & 6 (we are stocked on the other sizes). Totally out of size 6, tho!
- ♦ Pull-ups (all sizes)
- \Diamond Gas cards so our clients can attend parenting classes
- ♦ Gently used medium to large baby gift bags (we re-use them for our New Mommy Bags)
- ♦ Gently used children's shoes (all sizes)
- ♦ Body wash and bar soap
- ♦ Household cleaning products
- ♦ Breast pumps and baby monitors
- Shaving cream and razors

Safety First New Parent Class

November, 2016, brought the increo ible news that we would be granted money to conduct a Safety First New Parent Class allowing our eligible clients to attend a Saturday training in very basic child care and earn themselves either a brand new car seat or a brand new crib just by attending!

To be eligible for this incredible, free much needed item, she needs to be at least 20 weeks along with her first child or her first child must be 6 months old or younger.

She will need to become a client of ours at least one week prior to the class she wishes to attend but all that requires is filling out our paperwork.

This is a very basic child care class, therefore, this must be her first child We will be discussing feeding, changing, diapering, safety in the home and while away, basic infant first aid and CPR (not for certification), and

By attending she will also earn around 250 "points" to use in our Baby Boutique on such things as new clothing, diapers, etc.

Know anyone who needs to attend? Please have that person contact us to set up an appointment to fill out our paperwork and get signed up for the

Our next scheduled class will be Saturday, March 25. We will be scheduling other dates soon.
