WELCOME TERI SOKULSKI



NEW GRAND PIANO

In July, the Calvary Church Council approved the purchasing of a new Grand Piano for the Sanctuary for \$46,300. The current piano will be placed in Bethany Hall for use. The new Grand Piano will be paid for by \$25,000 of existing and dedicated

memorial funds. The remaining balance of \$21,300 has been fully raised by generous lead gifts. An additional \$2,000 has been raised to support the updating of the old Grand Piano, organ maintenance and possibly other new





The following explanations supplement the church's monthly financial reports, and are intended to provide a brief & simplified overview of financial activity.

Contributions for July 2019 -- July 2019's General Fund and Special Offerings totaled \$67,798 which was 10% over July 2018.

Expenses for July 2019 -- July 2019's expenses totaled \$68,535 which is 5.5% over July 2018.

In Summary that leaves a July Deficit of \$(737) and a seven month ending deficit of \$(61,313). Our Contributions are currently 4.5% behind or projected budget and our expenses are currently 3.5% ahead of or projected budget.

Remarks from the President

Our Calvary staff has carefully made amazing plans for impactful and meaningful programming at church this fall, and I urge you and your families to make an extra effort to be active in the life of our congregation as we begin this exciting season.

Our congregation is fortunate to have such a talented team of pastors and program staff who are committed to trying new ideas, and exploring ways to enhance and enrich our lives, through our connection with Calvary Lutheran Church.



Rapidly changing demographics and cultural trends are negatively impacting many congregations in our Southwestern Minnesota Synod of the ELCA (and in the United States), and Calvary is not immune to these challenges. Fortunately, we continue to flourish under the leadership of our clergy, and many lay members who regularly contribute their time & talents for the benefit of this wonderful congregation.

So again, please be present and engaged with your fellow members, as Calvary moves into the new programming season!



EMBRACING THE CARE OF CREATION

As we embark on the new 2019-2020 program year, we invite everyone to be part of our Creation Care Team at Calvary. God calls each of us to be caretakers and stewards of this amazing creation which is our earthly home. We're grateful for the people who have stepped forward to serve on the Coordination team for our emerging creation care ministry. The September meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 24 at 7:00 p.m. in the Friendship room, and we invite anyone interested in supporting this effort to join us.

We recognize that the environmental threats we are facing is a global issue. We are grateful for the many nations and agencies which have stepped up to address and take action to meet the challenge of these threats. It is also encouraging to know that Church bodies around the world are acting to deal with the climate crisis. You need to know that **Sunday, September 1, will be observed as the WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CARE OF CREATION.** This observance began among the world Orthodox Christian community in 1989 under the leadership of Patriarch Bartholomew. And in an ecumenical gesture of global significance, Pope Francis announced on August of 2015 that the Roman Catholic Church would also recognize Sept. 1 as the World Day of Prayer for All Creation. Here in the United States, the National Council of Churches USA has also stepped forward to encourage broad ecumenical participation in this Sept. 1 emphasis. In addition, Blessed Tomorrow, a broad coalition of denominations, including our ELCA, is working cooperatively to strengthen our care of creation work and has invited our participation individually and as congregations in the Sept. I Day of Prayer. On that day, we invite you pray the following prayer:

God of the universe, we thank you for your many good gifts – For the beauty of Creation and its rich and varied fruits, for clean water and fresh air, for food and shelter, animals and plants. Forgive us for the times we have taken the earth's resources for granted and wasted what you have given us. Transform our hearts and minds, so that we would learn to treat the earth with gentleness and love, respecting all living things. Help us to respect the rights of all people and all species, and help us to generously share your gifts today and always. Amen.
