A CREATION CARE TIP on preventing plastic pollution. What is healthy for us is also healthy for the environment and this includes reducing the use of single-use plastic. Many products come wrapped in plastic and though it's convenient, it's polluting our earth and it never goes away. Plastic is made from petroleum and is loaded with chemicals that leaches from landfills into soil and water, animals die when they consume plastic. Be a wise consumer by looking for items that are not packaged in plastic. Reduce the use of single-use plastic bags. Refuse them at the grocery store and use paper bags. Only about 3% of plastic bags get recycled; the other 97% ends up in landfills because it's cheaper to just make new bags than to make them out of recycled bags.
