Introduction to the day

Today's gospel opens with further reflection on Jesus' baptism. He is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world and the one anointed by the Spirit. In the liturgy we come and see Christ revealed among us in word and meal. We go forth to invite others to come and worship the Holy One and to receive the gifts of grace and peace made known among us.

Gathering

Confession and Forgiveness

Blessed be the holy Trinity, + one God, the eternal voice from heaven, the anointed and beloved one, the Spirit moving over the waters. **Amen.**

As we approach the mystery of God, let us come in confession, trusting the love of Christ crucified and risen.

God who searches us and knows us,

you have shown us what is good, but we have looked to other lights to find our way. We have not been just in our dealings with others. We have chosen revenge over mercy. We have promoted ourselves instead of walking humbly with you. With what shall we come before you? Forgive us our sin, and show us your salvation in the face of Jesus Christ our Savior. Amen. Beloved of God, you have not received the spirit of the world, but the Spirit that is from God, poured out for you in the faithfulness of Jesus Christ. Receive the promise of baptism: You are God's child; ↔ your sins are forgiven. Rejoice and be glad, for yours is the reign of heaven. **Amen.**

First Reading: Isaiah 49:1-7 (GNT Pew Bible page 861)

¹ Listen to me, distant nations, you people who live far away!

Before I was born, the Lord chose me and appointed me to be his servant.

² He made my words as sharp as a sword. With his own hand he protected me.

He made me like an arrow,

sharp and ready for use.

³ He said to me, "Israel, you are my servant; because of you, people will praise me."

⁴ I said, "I have worked, but how hopeless it is! I have used up my strength, but have accomplished nothing." Yet I can trust the Lord to defend my cause; he will reward me for what I do.

⁵ Before I was born, the Lord appointed me; he made me his servant to bring back his people,

to bring back the scattered people of Israel.

The Lord gives me honor;

he is the source of my strength.

⁶ The Lord said to me,

"I have a greater task for you, my servant. Not only will you restore to greatness the people of Israel who have survived,

but I will also make you a light to the nations so that all the world may be saved."

⁷ Israel's holy God and savior says to the one who is deeply despised, who is hated by the nations and is the servant of rulers:

"Kings will see you released and will rise to show their respect; princes also will see it,

and they will bow low to honor you."

This will happen because the Lord has chosen his servant; the holy God of Israel keeps his promises.

¹ From Paul, who was called by the will of God to be an apostle of Christ Jesus, and from our brother Sosthenes—


² To the church of God which is in Corinth, to all who are called to be God's holy people, who belong to him in union with Christ Jesus, together with all people everywhere who worship our Lord Jesus Christ, their Lord and ours:

³ May God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ give you grace and peace. Blessings in Christ

⁴ I always give thanks to my God for you because of the grace he has given you through Christ Jesus. ⁵ For in union with Christ you have become rich in all things, including all speech and all knowledge. ⁶ The message about Christ has become so firmly established in you ⁷ that you have not failed to receive a single blessing, as you wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed. ⁸ He will also keep you firm to the end, so that you will be faultless on the Day of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹ God is to be trusted, the God who called you to have fellowship with his Son Jesus Christ, our Lord.

Gospel: John 1:29-42 (GNT Pew Bible page 1265)

²⁹ The next day John [the Baptist] saw Jesus coming to him, and said, "There is the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! ³⁰ This is the one I was talking about when I said, 'A man is coming after me, but he is greater than I am, because he existed before I was born.' ³¹ I did not know who he would be, but I came baptizing with water in order to make him known to the people of Israel."

³² And John gave this testimony: "I saw the Spirit come down like a dove from heaven and stay on him. ³³ I still did not know that he was the one, but God, who sent me to baptize with water, had said to me, 'You will see the Spirit come down and stay on a man; he is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' ³⁴ I have seen it," said John, "and I tell you that he is the Son of God."

³⁵ The next day John was standing there again with two of his disciples, ³⁶ when he saw Jesus walking by. "There is the Lamb of God!" he said.

³⁷ The two disciples heard him say this and went with Jesus. ³⁸ Jesus turned, saw them following him, and asked, "What are you looking for?"

They answered, "Where do you live, Rabbi?" (This word means "Teacher.")

³⁹ "Come and see," he answered. (It was then about four o'clock in the afternoon.) So they went with him and saw where he lived, and spent the rest of that day with him.

⁴⁰ One of them was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. ⁴¹ At once he found his brother Simon and told him, "We have found the Messiah." (This word means "Christ.") ⁴² Then he took Simon to Jesus.

Jesus looked at him and said, "Your name is Simon son of John, but you will be called Cephas." (This is the same as Peter and means "a rock.")


