During internship I’m given the opportunity to develop a project in the congregation, and I’ve been approved to design a three-year confirmation curriculum for Calvary. This past summer, Pastor Naomi and I developed a curriculum for this current year to explore the Old Testament, so I will continue this project with years focused on the New Testament and Small Catechism. One thing I’ve learned so far is that there are many educational materials available to purchase, but often the most effective materials are those designed for a specific context.

At Calvary, we are unique in that confirmation begins at 6:00 on Wednesday’s with Dinner Church. Everyone gathered, confirmation students and small group leaders, as well as others from the congregation and community, shares a meal and hears the confirmation Scripture reading for the week. We have conversations at the tables around this reading and share Holy Communion. Then, after worship, the confirmation students continue their lesson through a variety of interactive methods.

Wednesday evenings have been a regular highlight of my week. I have loved getting to know the confirmation students and small group leaders and the other Dinner Church participants. What I’m learning is that each person has something to share. We can all learn from each other.

My hope for Calvary is that we will look for ways to further our learning, further our relationship with Jesus, through our relationships with one another. We’d love to have you join us on Wednesday’s for Dinner Church, because we want to learn from you too.

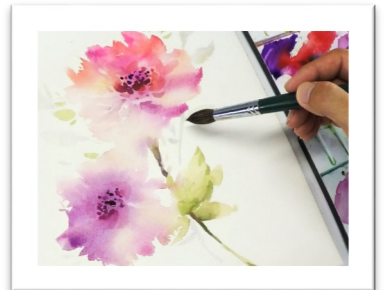
## Creative Heart - Wednesdays - January 29, February 5 and 12 – 5-6 PM

You can enjoy all kinds of family friendly on-site activities such as swimming, fishing, boating, paddleboards, nature walks, playground, and board games. Potential off-site activities include exploring Two Harbors, North Shore sites, and Duluth or Ely attractions. Families sleep together in comfy, but rustic cabins (toilets and showers are in a bath house, not in cabins), or bring your camper/tent.

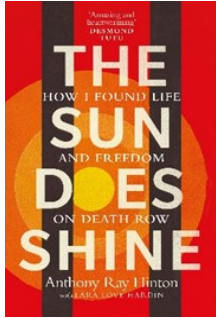

Parishioners Executive Financial Summary  
December 2019

The following explanations supplement the church's monthly financial reports and are intended to provide a brief & simplified overview of financial activity.

Contributions for December 2019 – December 2019's General Fund and Special Offerings totaled \$105,680.38.

Expenses for December 2019 – December 2019's expenses totaled \$88,999.66 which is within 1% 2018.

In Summary that leaves a Surplus for December of \$16,680.72 and a twelve month ending deficit of \$(9,166). Our Contributions were 5% higher than Calvary's projected contributions and our expenses are currently 5% ahead of our projected Expenses.

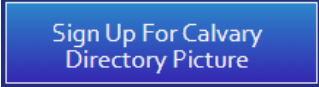
