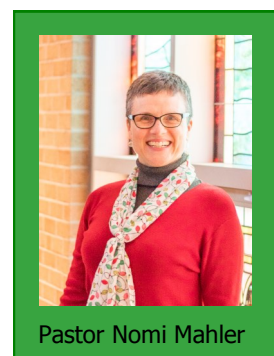

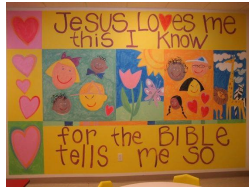

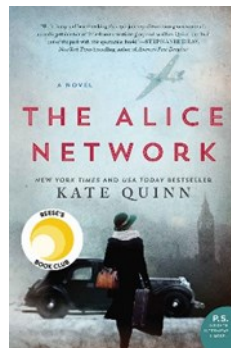

RESOLUTION TO BECOME A "LUTHERANS RESTORING CREATION SYNOD"

Dear Calvary Partners in Caring for Creation:

I think most of us are aware that the climate and environmental threat to our planet is very real. But the global dimensions of this crisis can make us feel that what we can do individually, or even together as a congregation is too insignificant to make a difference. So it was very heartening for me to go to our Lakeland Conference meeting on Sun., Feb. 16 at Nordland Lutheran Church near Hawick and to participate in adopting a Resolution for our SW MN Synod to become a Lutherans Restoring Creation Synod. A Resolution is a rather formal way of proposing an action that utilizes "whereas" statements and "therefore be it resolved that..." language. It excites and encourages me to think what a big step it will be for our creation restoring endeavor if every conference and congregation in our Synod would join in embracing God's call to care for creation.

Here is the wording of the first "whereas" and the "therefore be it resolved..."

"Whereas, the ELCA Social Statement Caring for Creation affirms that we are called to care for the earth as God cares for the earth; and recognizes that action to counter degradation, especially within this decade, is essential to the future of our children and our children's children; and declares that each congregation should see itself as a center for exploring scriptural and theological foundations for creation; and that as congregations, we will seek to incorporate the principles of sufficiency and sustainability in our life. **Therefore, be it resolved that the SWMN Synod become a Lutherans Restoring Creation Synod."**

This resolution will be presented for adoption at our Synod Assembly at Redwood Falls on June 12-14. Please join me in praying for its adoption.
