Join other friends and families from Calvary on August 2-6 for a relaxing north woods get-away at Camp House in Brimson, MN! Camp House is one of GLLM's Bible camps located 30 Minutes from Two Harbors, MN. It is remote and removed from the hustle and bustle of "regular" life on a small quiet lake.

There will be opportunity to enjoy on-site activities such as

swimming, fishing, boating, nature walks, playground and board games. Potential off-site activities include exploring Two Harbors, a visit to Gooseberry Falls, North Shore activities, Duluth or Ely attractions.

Sleep in comfy, but rustic cabins-toilets and showers are in a bath house on site, not in cabins, or bring your camper/tent.


