### What Does This Mean?

Luther's often repeated question in the Catechism

As we Lutherans mark and observe the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Reformation this year, let me introduce you to a Sunday morning adult study that will begin at Calvary, Rally Sunday, September 10. It is called *By Heart – Conversations with Luther's Small Catechism.* 

By Heart is a 7-session course that will engage us with the Small Catechism. As the simple English alphabet is the foundation to our English language, so Luther's *Small Catechism* serves as the cornerstone to our Christian faith. How we are to live as people of faith, who God is and what God has done, how we are to communicate with God, and how God reaches down and touches us

(Word & Sacrament) are all taught in understandable and simple (not simplistic) form in Luther's Small Catechism. For hundreds of years we continue to use this tool as we teach the basics of the Christian faith to our young people and youth (Confirmation).

Like Luther's Small Catechism this learning opportunity aims to create and nurture faith. *By Heart* is for adults who have never encountered the Small Catechism, and it is for adults who studied and memorized it as teens back in confirmation class. It is for those new to the faith; it is for those old to the faith.

Who of us has ever 'arrived' when it comes to the basic understandings of our Christian faith? I hope you will consider joining us for this timely study. Furthermore, perhaps you know of someone you might consider inviting.


