### Singing in Worship March 25 - Palm Sunday


ALL Sunday school children ages 3 years old through Grade 6 will process in with palms and sing during our 10:15 AM Palm Sunday Worship service!

March is Food Share Month and even though Calvary distributes food to the Willmar Area Food Shelf monthly, every year we like to put a special emphasis on the need for the food given out by the food shelf in Kandiyohi County and the

surrounding area during Food Share Month. Saturday, March 10 and Sunday, March 11 is scheduled for our Food Shelf Weekend this year. We will have the grocery cart and a representative from the Social Concerns Committee at the Saturday service. We accept either non-perishable food products or monetary donations. On Sunday, we will have a processional offering at each service for both the donations of food or money for the food shelf plus your regular offering. We will stack the food up in front of the altar, so we can all see the growth of the donated food products. Please help us reach our combined pounds and money goal of "a ton" or 2000 combined total. # HATS FOR TANZANIA Help Us Get 100

Our Hats for Honduras project has taken on a new name and mission. We are still making hats, but now, these hats will be sent to our mission in Tanzania. Our missionaries Steve and Jody Swanson, are instrumental in the NICU and hospital in Tanzania. These hats are used for preserving the body temperature of these tiny babies. Tanzania is a warm place so these hats need to be made of lightweight yarn and are geared for newborns and/or preemies. Yarn should be baby, sport or other light weight yarn. We will collect these hats and get them to the missionaries yearly. We have about 40 hats currently. We plan to get the hats to where they need to be by April 20. We are putting out a plea for 60 more hats in the next month. Please place your completed hats on the Social Concern Shelf across from the Welcome center. Thank you!
