

The Resurrection Brings Spring Showers and Flowers

Grace and Peace to you all in the name of our Resurrected Jesus. It is a great way to begin the month of April with shouts from around the world, "Christ has risen--Christ has risen indeed!" The Easter proclamation rings around the planet. It begins and continues through April into May.



Letter from the Church President

Special Congregational Meeting – May 6, 2018

The Calvary Lutheran Church Council recently approved the calling of a special congregational meeting scheduled for May 6, 2018. The sole purpose of the Special Meeting is to vote on a Council approved resolution calling for the sale of the Anderson Farm Land. As you may recall, this was discussed back in January at the Annual Meeting and also at the "Coffee with the Council" meeting held the Sunday before the Annual Meeting. The Council approved resolution is:

SALE OF ANDERSON FARM RESOLUTION

WHEREAS Calvary Lutheran Church was the recipient of a generous gift from Mr. Jerry Anderson of 407 acres of farmland near Atwater, MN and WHEREAS Calvary Lutheran Church has acquired the property located west of the Church formerly occupied by Bethesda Heritage Place and WHEREAS Calvary Lutheran Church has secured bank financing to purchase this real estate and incurred demolition costs of which there is still outstanding debt and a mortgage on this property THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That Calvary Lutheran Church approves selling the 407 acres of the Anderson Farm real estate with the following provisions:

- The selling price of the farmland shall be no less than \$7,000 per acre to be sold by public auction or sealed bid
- The sale shall occur within twelve (12) months of this date
- The proceeds shall be directed to fully pay off the outstanding debt and mortgage at Concorde Bank in the original amount of \$1.1 million and an approximate balance as of March 14, 2018 of \$810,000.

Any remaining proceeds from the sale of the land will be deposited into a designated Anderson Capital Fund account and be used in accordance to the terms of his bequest

Background

The initial recommendation to sell the Anderson Farm originated from the Building Committee, the Committee that has been working for the past 3-4 years on a building project that aligns with the Calvary Strategic Plan. From that work developed three core strategic facility objectives:

- Worship and adjoining space for fellowship and welcoming
- Youth center and dedicated youth spaces
- Enhance communication via horizontal and vertical connections

Significant work was developed including two different financing options that included Stewardship, Pledges, Cash and Borrowing.

Option A: Borrow up to \$1.3 million (Includes sale of Anderson property) **Option B:** Borrow up to \$4.3 million (not selling Anderson property)

The Building Committee unanimously recommended to the Council that Option B was not a viable financing option due to the additional Net Annual Debt Service, which would be on top of the additional Stewardship/Pledges necessary to make the plan work.

As such, the Council accepted the Building Committee's recommendation and believes that before any further work is done on any building project that a decision needs to be made by the Congregation on selling or keeping the Anderson Farm Land.

If the Resolution is adopted by a 2/3 majority at the Special Congregational Meeting, it would set a direction that Calvary could move forward in further developing programming and space aligned with the Strategic Plan. Please mark the May 6 date on your calendars as we encourage all members to attend the Special Congregational Meeting.



I want to provide you an update on where we – Calvary Lutheran – are at in the process of selecting a new pastor.

The Synod has an established 7 milestone process flow they use and which I want to share now and in future updates to keep the congregation aware of progress within and across each milestone:




The Call Committee was established in February and includes a range of congregation member backgrounds to ensure we have a broad perspective in this important journey. The members are: Shane Baker, Meghan Knott, Michael Newberg, Deborah Larson, Abby Teisinger, Jaime Hultgren, Charles Ulrich, Mike Haugsby.

We will meet for the first time with the Synod liaison, Linda Pederson, on Sunday, March 18, when she will provide the Call Committee with more detail on the next steps within the current milestone – consideration of candidates. We will be receiving information for potential candidates, evaluating, meeting and interviewing candidates. While I will continue to share updates with the congregation, this is a period requiring confidentiality and maintained proprieties by the Call Committee to others about candidate specifics being considered.

The Call Committee will use the Ministry Site Profile as created by the Transition Team and approved by the Church Council to guide us in evaluations of a candidate fitting to who we are as a congregation, what our priorities and passions are looking forward and what we are collectively looking for in our next pastor to lead us forward together in realizing our mission in the Willmar area and beyond.

We welcome the consideration of us in your prayers, as we all ask for divine guidance over the Call Committee in this important process.
