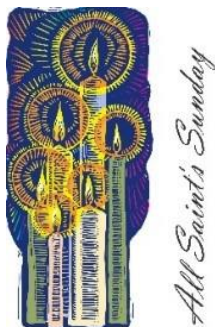


## IN CHRIST'S NAME WELCOME TO CALVARY THIS FESTIVAL DAY

### Sunday, November 11

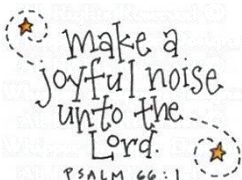

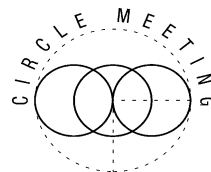
