Enhancements

The following enhancements have been made in this release.

DISCONTINUE MEDICATION WINDOW

- When you select **Adverse reaction** or **Allergic reaction** as a discontinue reason, a new section expands where you can enter details about the reaction. When you click **OK**, the Allergy Management window appears with the medication name and reaction date already populated and the **Allergy** or **Adverse Reaction** option already selected. You can change and/or add information to this window and then click the **Save** button. The allergy list will be saved and the medication will be moved from **Current** to **Historical**. (128433)

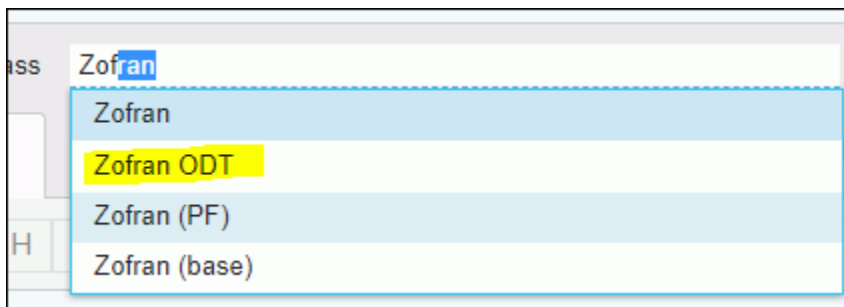

DRUG SEARCH

- Non-dispensable drugs will no longer display in the search results. (127364)
- When you search for a brand name drug, the results now show both obsolete and active brand name drugs as well as any dispensable generic options for that brand. The generic options can be selected and prescribed from the list. (129835, 129836)

Example: Zofran ODT is obsolete but you do not remember the name of the generic equivalent. You can search for and choose Zofran ODT and see the generics in the results list.

- In the drug search results, the **Generic** column now is selectable.

Example: You can search for a brand name (Lipitor) and select and prescribe the generic (atorvastatin) from the search results list.

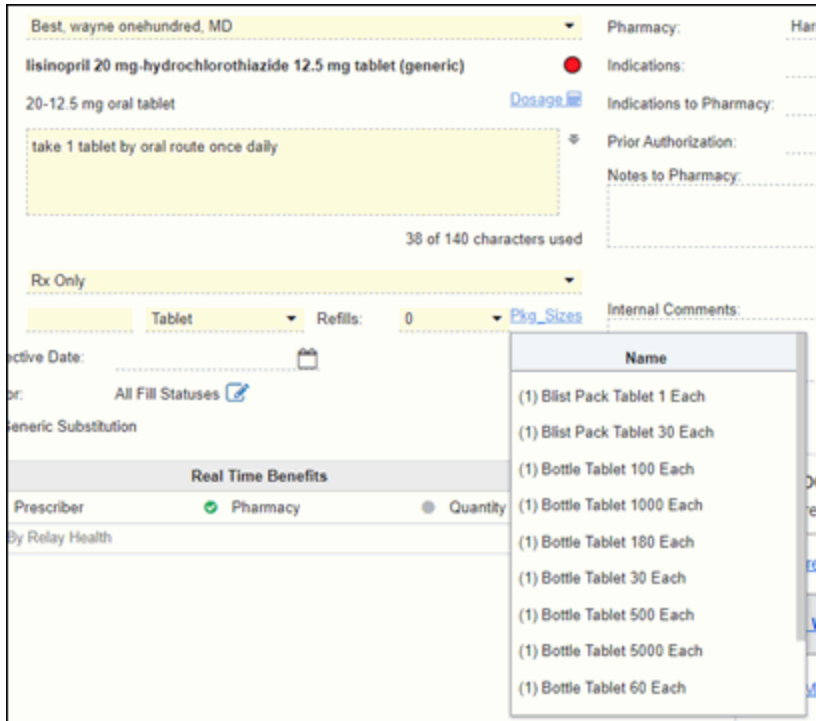

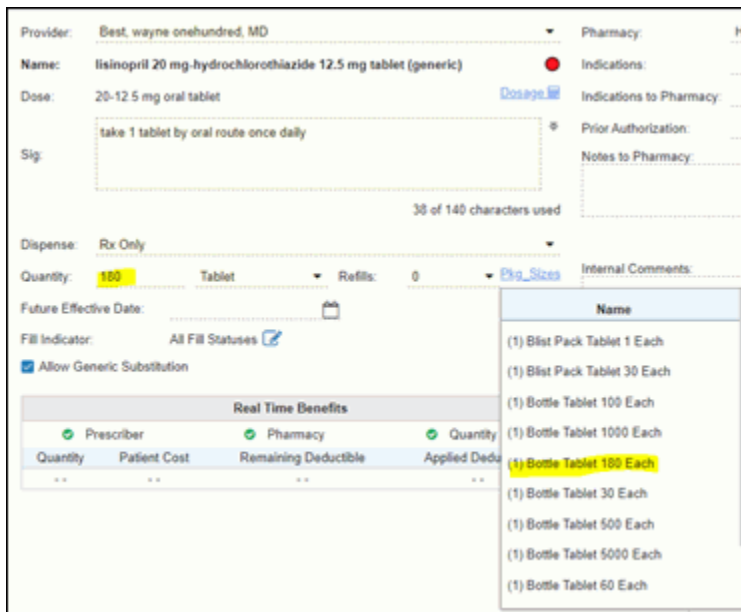
SCRIPTWRITER

- When you click the **Pkg Sizes** link to view available package size information, you now can select an item from the list. The **Quantity** field will automatically populate with the information from the item you select. For DME packages, the information will also populate in the **Notes to Pharmacy** field. (128353)

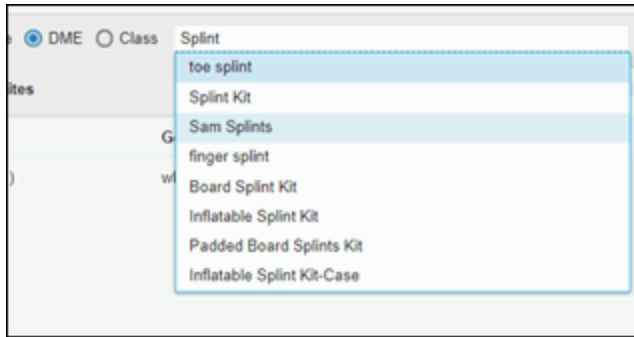
Example: When you prescribe lisinopril 20m hydrochlorothiazide 12.5 mg tablet, you have several packaging/dispense options from which to choose.



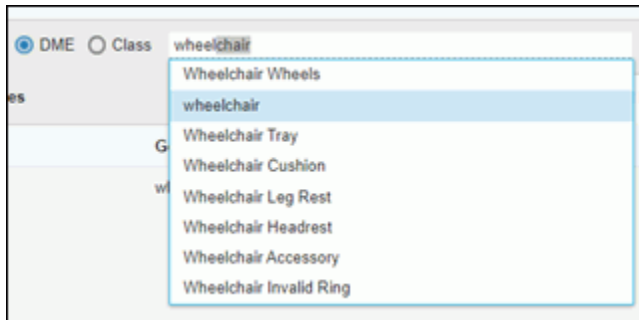
The **Quantity** field will automatically populate based on the package selection.



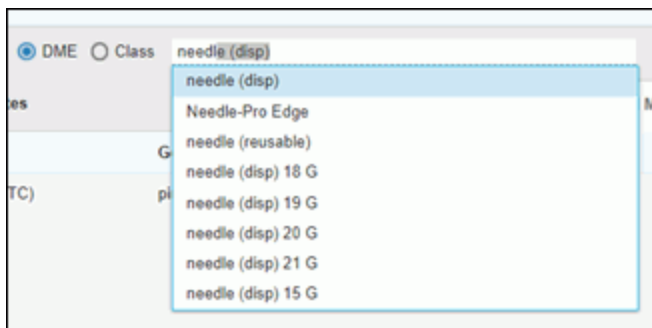
- The DME search has been improved to return more information. (129973)
 Example: Search for splint:



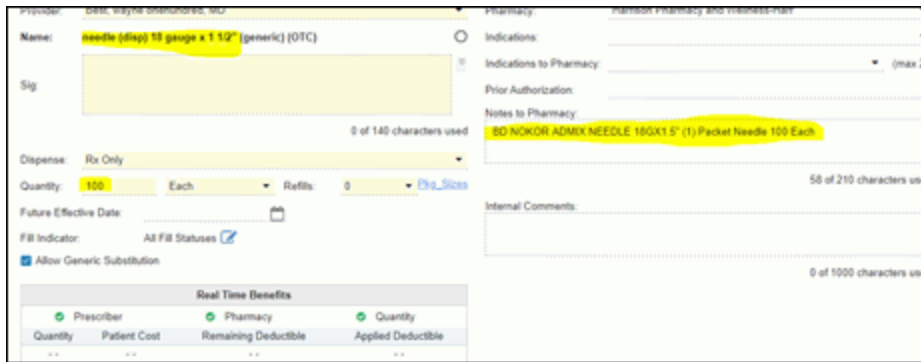
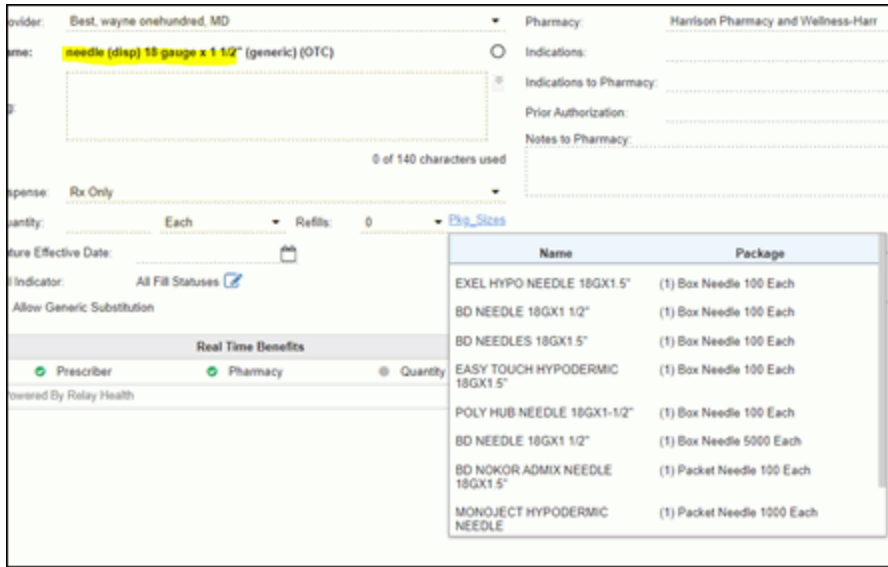
Example: Search for wheelchair.



Example: Search for needles.

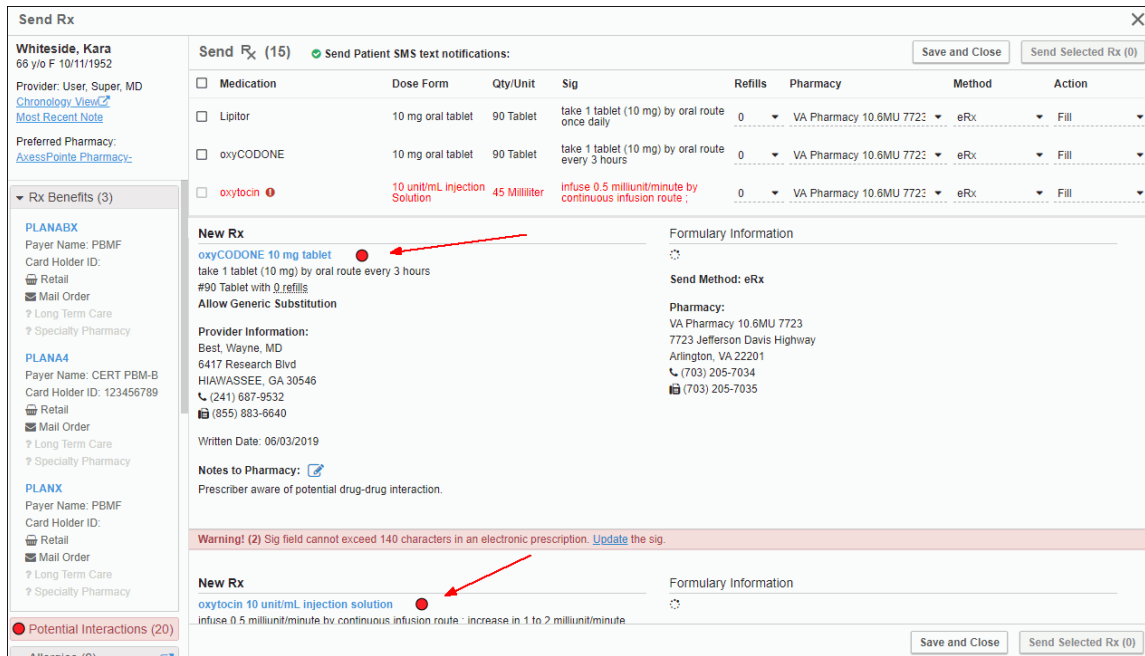


Click the **Pkg Sizes** link to select the appropriate packaging. When you select the packaging, the **Quantity** field is populated automatically, and the packaging selection is automatically placed in the **Notes to Pharmacy** field.



SEND RX WINDOW

- The red warning banner for potential interactions has been replaced with the red circle icon. Click this icon to display the interaction warning details. Hover over the circle icon to display the ignore reason (if available). The circle icon displays for pending, current, and discontinued drugs only. (127365)



Resolved Items

The following items were identified in a previous release and have been corrected in this release.

SEND RX WINDOW

- A 'Failed generating CMM Response' error no longer displays when you click the **Prior Auth** button. (129686)
- DrFirst demographics mismatch error: When you receive an EPCS Rx change request from a pharmacy and the patient demographics in the Rx change request do not match what is on file, the Rx change response now will be sent as **Approved with Changes**. (130308)
- When a duplicate renewal request (a request for the same prescription and patient) is received and the previous renewal request is not older than 28 days, the system now automatically denies the duplicate request. If the previous renewal request is older than 28 days, the duplicate renewal request will be processed. (130309)
