**EVENT INFO**

US Chess membership is required for this event. Memberships will be available on-site or at <http://www.uschess.org>. (Annual membership is \$17-\$26.)

This is a Kentucky State Championship Event. As a championship event, tournament directors will NOT be allowed to intervene in games other than as prescribed by USChess Official Rules of Chess.

**SECTIONS**

Players must play in the appropriate grade-level section. Kindergarteners and 1<sup>st</sup> Graders may choose from K-1, K-3, and K-5. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Graders may choose between K-3 and K-5.

K-1, K-3: 5 swiss rounds G/30, 5 second delay – ONE DAY SCHEDULE

K-5, 6-8, 9-12: 5 swiss rounds G/70, 5 second delay – TWO DAY SCHEDULE

Time control and number of rounds may be changed based on turnout. The KCA also reserves the right to accelerate pairings based on turnout.

K-1, K-3:                      Saturday, Mar. 21. Round 1 at 9 a.m., all other rounds ASAP, with a guaranteed 45 minute break for lunch.

K-5, 6-8, 9-12:           Saturday, Mar. 21. Rounds at 9 a.m., 12:30 p.m., 3 p.m.  
Sunday, Mar. 22. Rounds at 9 a.m. and 12:30 p.m.
