

Macon Mayhem Jimmy Soper 2018-19 game worn gloves, size 14”.

Waterloo, Ontario native Jimmy Soper played junior hockey in 2013-15 and college hockey in 2016-17 before beginning his professional career with the Danville Dashers of the Federal Hockey League in 2017-18. He joined the Mayhem around the final third of the 2017-18 season, appearing in 20 games and tallying 10 points (3 G, 7 A) and scoring a goal in his first-ever SPHL game. In 2018-19, Soper started the season with the ECHL Newfoundland Growlers and returned to Macon where he tallied 6 goals with 10 assists. These Warrior Alpha QX Pro gloves are the perfect balance of traditional looks and modern anatomical feel that improves puck control and better protects your hands. The hybrid flex cuffs extend your range of motion, improving puck handling while still protecting your wrists from slashes. Extremely lightweight Phantom Foam protection combined with shield inserts absorbs big impacts. The tapered fit allows the 4-roll glove to contour to the natural shape of the hand, maximizing mobility and improving protection. Responsive Lycra gussets, AXI-Flex Thumb, and the anatomical stretch backhand give these Alpha gloves a noticeably snappy, game-ready feel right off the shelf. The Wartech FNC yellow liner is made with Polygiene fabric to keep the interior dry and odor free. I purchased these gloves directly from the team at the end of the season.
