

Atlanta Thrashers J.P. Vigier 2006-07 game worn gloves.

J.P Vigier was born in Notre Dame du Lordes, Manitoba and played junior hockey with the Portage Terriers in the Manitoba Junior Hockey League, before accepting a full scholarship to Northern Michigan University. After playing parts of six seasons with the Thrashers, Vigier found himself watching from the stands during Atlanta's one and only playoff appearance, despite finishing the season with 13 points and a 0 +/- rating in 72 games. The undrafted winger amassed 23 goals with 23 assists in 213 NHL regular season games with the Thrashers before moving overseas to Switzerland at the conclusion of the 2006-07 season. He would retire in 2012 after playing three seasons with Bern of the Swiss-A League, winning one championship. These 14" Reebok 10K navy gloves have light blue and gold accents. The left palm shows the most wear, with team repairs on both palms. VIGIER is embroidered on the wrist protector. These gloves are similar to gloves being worn by Vigier in photographs taken during the latter part of his last season in Atlanta. I obtained these gloves from another collector.
