

Atlanta Thrashers Serge Aubin 2005-06 game worn gloves.

Val-d'Or, Quebec native Serge Aubin was drafted by the Pittsburgh Penguins in the 7th Round of the 1994 NHL Entry Draft. He played 374 games in the National Hockey League for the Colorado Avalanche, Columbus Blue Jackets and Atlanta Thrashers. Aubin had his best season with the Blue Jackets in 2000–01, scoring 13 goals and 17 assists for 30 points and only missed one game the entire season. After his second season with Columbus, he returned to the Avalanche for one season before being claimed by the Atlanta Thrashers in the NHL waiver draft. In the 2003–04 season, he scored 25 points, 5 short of his NHL career best in point-scoring. During the 2004–05 NHL lockout, Aubin played in Switzerland for Genève-Servette HC. Aubin returned to Atlanta for the 2005–06 season, his last in the NHL. These 15" Eagle CP95 navy gloves have dark red trim. The left palm exhibits the most wear but the right palm also has a small tear. #10 is hand written in black Sharpie on the cuffs, suggesting that these gloves were worn for evaluation purposes before a custom made set having Aubin's name printed on were obtained. These gloves are similar to gloves being worn by Aubin in photographs taken during his last season in Atlanta. I obtained these gloves from another collector.
