

Georgia Institute of Technology Colin Fessler 2020 game worn jersey, size XXL goalie cut.

Kohler, Wisconsin native Colin Fessler came to the Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets after four years of high school hockey with the Sheboygan Red Raiders. In 62 games, he finished with a 10-16-1 record with 4.44 GAA and an .860 save percentage. In his freshman year at Tech, he appeared in 15 regular season games with an 8-5-2 record with a 2.77 GAA and .905 save percentage. He was voted the Most Valuable Player in the Savannah Hockey Classic. These Rebirth Sports limited edition alternate jerseys were worn by the Jackets during the 2020 Savannah Hockey Classic. The front of this heavyweight jersey has the Georgia Tech alternate logo made from gold twill with embroidered letters and border. The ACHA and Rebirth logos are embroidered directly to the jersey, as are the Rebirth logos on the back. The back and sleeve numbers consist of two color sewn twill. A fight strap is sewn onto the back. There are numerous puck marks on the front and goal post paint on the sleeves. It has been photo matched to pictures taken of Fessler during the final game of the tournament. Tech was defeated by the University of Georgia in a shootout in the Championship Game to re-claim the tournament's Thrasher Cup. I purchased this jersey directly from the team.
