

Atlanta Flames Rey Comeau 1974-75 game worn jersey, size 46.

Reynald Xavier Comeau was one of the original Flames players, acquired in the same deal that brought Phil Myre to Atlanta from Montreal. Comeau played in all of the team's first six seasons and was the only player who wore number 18 during those years. He occupies the sixth position in all-time scoring for the Flames. This red road jersey has the Flames two color sewn twill logo on the front, along with two color sewn twill numbers on the sleeves and back. A garter style fight strap is sewn inside the lower back. An embroidered Rawlings neck tag is sewn on and bears a 2" shorter custom tag. At only 5'8" and 190 pounds, one could understand why this jersey was custom made 2" shorter for Comeau. There are multiple team repairs, stick marks and board burns on this durene classic. This jersey was acquired from another collector via an eBay auction.
