

Atlanta Knights Stan Drulia 1993-94 game worn jersey, size XL.

1993-94 was Stan Drulia's best season for the Knights, scoring 54 goals with 60 assists for 114 points, leading the team to the IHL Turner Cup Championship. During the sixteen playoff games, Drulia posted 25 points, scoring 13 goals. He was awarded the Norman R. "Bud" Poile Trophy as the IHL Playoff MVP. Drulia holds the all-time Knights records for goals, assists and total points, and is second only to Christian Campeau in total games played. This white M Sport mesh jersey has great game wear and team repairs. It has the Knights embroidered logo sewn and embroidered on the front, sewn two color twill numbers on the back and sleeves. M Sport and IHL logos are embroidered directly to the jersey at the right rear hem line. Also in two color twill is Drulia's captains C, which he wore for three seasons in Atlanta. Both sleeves have extensive damage, with team repairs in white and black twill on the inside. There are numerous stick marks and a small tear on the right rear hemline, just above and right of the IHL logo. I purchased this jersey from an eBay auction and restored the missing nameplate with matching fabric and sewn two color twill letters according to team specifications.
