

**Atlanta Knights Colin Miller 1993-94 game worn jersey, size XL.**

Grimsby, Ontario native Colin Miller came to the Knights straight out of major junior hockey in the Ontario Hockey League. Miller played for two and a half seasons with the Knights, playing in a total of 192 games. According to head trainer Kurt Harvey, these mesh jerseys were worn for the entire 1992-93 season and part way through the 1993-94 season. This home white M Sport mesh jersey has great game wear and extensive team repairs. On the front is the Knights embroidered logo, on the back and sleeves are sewn two color twill numbers. A matching fabric nameplate with sewn two color letters is sewn above the rear number. M Sport and IHL logos are embroidered directly to the jersey at the right rear hem line. Both sleeves have extensive damage, with team repairs in white and black twill on the inside. There are numerous stick marks and tears. I purchased this jersey from another collector.
