

**Augusta Lynx Steve Munn 2004-05 game worn jersey, size 58.**

Defenseman Steve Munn split the 2004-05 season with three teams, a two game call up with the AHL Providence Bruins, 17 games with the Augusta Lynx before finishing the season with the Trenton Titans, helping to guide the Titans to the ECHL Kelly Cup Championship that season. While he only played one season for the Lynx, the Saskatchewan native met his future wife in Augusta and made it his home following his pro hockey career. This black set 1 jersey by Reebok has the traditional embroidered lynx head patch sewn on front with the alternate paw and puck logos on the shoulders. On the back, the cloth nameplate has sewn white letters, and the numbers consists of two color sewn twill. The back hem has sewn on embroidered ECHL and Meigray patches. The sleeve numbers are also sewn two color twill. A Dodge sponsor patch is sewn on the upper right front. Two Reebok logo patches are sewn under the neck on the back and on the left upper chest on front. This style of jersey was worn for four seasons between 2004-05 and 2007-08, the only major difference being the sponsor patches sewn on the front. This jersey was purchased directly from Meigray.
