

Atlanta Thrashers Garnet Exelby 2007 game worn playoff jersey, size 58.

This set 3 Reebok home jersey was worn by defenseman Garnet Exelby during the Thrashers only playoff appearance, losing in four straight to the New York Rangers. Exelby played in all four playoff games, finishing -1 with six penalty minutes. This was the last season before the advent of the Edge jerseys that incorporated several design changes. This jersey has the embroidered primary logo sewn on the front. Two color sewn twill numbers are on the back and right sleeve and two color sewn letters make up the nameplate. The controversial design element featuring the city name ATLANTA running down the left sleeve consists of embroidered letters. The embroidered NHL shield is sewn on the rear hem, and the embroidered Reebok logo is sewn above the nameplate. The arrow stripes are located only at the bottom hem, with blue mesh on the sides and sleeves. This jersey is complete with a letter of authenticity from the Thrashers and Meigray. I purchased it from Meigray.
