

Atlanta Thrashers Ramzi Abid 2005-06 game issued jersey, size 56.

This white Reebok Set 1 road jersey was purchased from Meigray as a name on back removed game used jersey. The only player that wore #23 during the 2005-06 regular season was Jim Slater, but Slater did wear #40 according to a training camp roster. Abid was signed by Atlanta as an unrestricted free agent on August 8, 2005 so this jersey could have originally been made up for him and worn during the pre-season or possibly during a pre-game skate in which Abid did not get into the lineup. Records indicate that Abid actually wore #24 in the six games he played in the regular season. Since I cannot confirm that Abid wore it in a game, I'm calling this game issued. It has the embroidered Thrashers logo sewn on the front, two alternate logo patches sewn onto each shoulder and sewn two color twill numbers. The player nameplate with two color twill letters has been removed from the back but some remains of the cut threads are visible. The size of the nameplate can be estimated from the threads remaining and is consistent with a short player name of no more than five letters. The embroidered NHL shield is located on the lower right hem. There are four areas with paint transfers on this otherwise clean jersey. The 2004-05 Meigray Game Worn Jersey tag from the lockout season has the '05-06 add on tag attached.
