

Atlanta Thrashers Shawn McEachern 2002-03 game worn jersey, size 54.

Massachusetts native Shawn McEachern played for five different teams during his 13-year NHL career. He scored over 30 goals in two different seasons and his best point total came in 2000–01 with Ottawa, when he notched 32 goals and 40 assists. He won a Stanley Cup with the Pittsburgh Penguins in 1992. This set 2 white CCM jersey from his first season in Atlanta has the embroidered Thrashers primary logo sewn on the front and two embroidered secondary logo patches sewn onto each shoulder. McEachern's captain C in two color twill is sewn on the front. A matching fabric nameplate with two color twill letters is sewn on the back. Player numbers in two color sewn twill are on the sleeves and back. The NHL shield is embroidered onto the rear hem and the embroidered CCM logo patch is sewn below the neckline on the back. The yellow arrow stripe trim around the neck and at the bottom hem finishes this jersey. There are numerous stick marks, board burns and team repairs, and the sleeves have been shortened approximately two inches. The jersey has been photo matched to a picture taken January 15, 2003. It came with a letter of authenticity from Meigray and the NHL. I acquired it from another collector.
