

Atlanta Thrashers Spencer Machacek 2008-09 NHL debut game worn jersey, size 56.

Alberta native Spencer Machacek began his major junior career in 2005–06 with the Vancouver Giants of the Western Hockey League (WHL). The right winger recorded 45 points in each of his first two seasons, playing an integral part in the Giants' 2006 President's Cup and 2007 Memorial Cup championships. In the 2007 NHL Entry Draft, Machacek was selected by the Atlanta Thrashers in the 3rd round, 67th overall. Machacek returned to the WHL in 2007-08 and was named team captain of the Giants. At the end of the first round of the 2008 WHL playoffs, he signed his first NHL contract with the Atlanta. After reporting to the Thrashers' training camp for the 2008–09 season, Machacek was assigned to their AHL affiliate Chicago Wolves. Late in the season, he was called up by the Thrashers and appeared in two games, making his NHL debut on March 16, 2009, wearing this jersey and recording 7 minutes and 21 seconds of playing time. This Reebok Edge 2.0 home third jersey shows no wear, as it was only worn for this one game. The Thrashers wordmark logo is done in two color twill with embroidered accents, with the player number in two color sewn twill below that. Sleeve and back numbers are also sewn two color twill. An embroidered Reebok logo patch is sewn on the upper back just below the neckline and above the matching fabric nameplate with two color sewn letters. On each shoulder are a pair of Thrashers alternate logo patches. The NHL shield logo patch is sewn to the neckline. The fight strap bears Machacek's autograph, obtained in person by the original owner, the same individual that I acquired this jersey from.
