

Gwinnett Gladiators Mike Vigilante 2006-07 game worn jersey, size 54.

Dearborn, Michigan native Mike Vigilante played four seasons with Lake Superior State University before beginning his professional career playing for head coach Jeff Pyle during the 2001-02 season with the Mobile Mysticks. During his rookie season, Vigilante posted 30 points, earning a call up to the Springfield Falcons of the AHL for 2 games. During 2002-03, he split the season between the Jackson Bandits and the Pensacola Ice Pilots before rejoining Pyle for the Gladiators inaugural season in 2003-04. Vigilante appeared in 18 games with the Gladiators that season before being called up to the Portland Pirates of the AHL for 59 games. During the 2004-05 and 2006-07 seasons, Vigilante played in all 72 regular season games for the Gladiators. He decided to take the 2005-06 season off in order to focus on his teaching certification and spend more time with his family. Returning to Gwinnett in 2006-07, Vigilante had had a career year with 25 goals and 40 assists, serving as the alternate captain in '06-07. This black SP jersey has the embroidery over twill Gladiator logo sewn on the front, along with the Gwinnett wordmark logo, the embroidered Kroger sponsor patch and the two color sewn twill alternate captain's A. The pair of smaller alternate logo patches are sewn on the shoulders. The two color twill numbers are sewn on, as was the matching black nameplate with single color letters. On the back hem the SP logo is embroidered to the jersey next to the ECHL embroidered logo patch that is sewn on. A sewn on Meigray patch is on the opposite side of the rear hem. This jersey has great game wear, especially on the left sleeve. I acquired it from another collector.
