

Gwinnett Gladiators Bryan Dobek 2007-08 game worn jersey, size 54.

This white set 1 jersey by SP was worn by California native Bryan Dobek during his last season of professional hockey. After one year of junior hockey in the NAHL, Dobek played for Bowling Green State University for four seasons before turning pro in the 2006-07 season. He split his first pro season between Gwinnett and the SPHL Fayetteville Fire Antz, having greater success in the SPHL, helping to lead Fayetteville to the SPHL Championship. Dobek only played ten games for the Gladiators during his final season so this jersey has light wear. It has the embroidered Gladiator logo sewn on the front, along with the Gladiators wordmark logo and the customary embroidered Kroger sponsor patch. A pair of smaller alternate logo patches are sewn on the shoulders. The two-color twill numbers are sewn on along with the fabric nameplate with single color letters. The size tag in the neck area was folded over and inadvertently captured by the stitching used to attach the nameplate. This jersey also has two anniversary patches; a twentieth anniversary ECHL patch sewn on the upper right chest and the fifth anniversary Gladiators patch sewn on the upper left chest. On the right side of the back hem the SP logo is embroidered to the jersey next to the sewn on ECHL embroidered logo. A Meigray embroidered patch is sewn on the left rear hem. I acquired this jersey directly from Meigray.
