

Gwinnett Gladiators Chris Poli 2010-11 game worn jersey, size 56.

2010-11 was Poli's only season with the Gladiators, playing in only 17 games before being dealt to Wheeling in early December. The Medfield, Massachusetts native and four year player at Brown University decided to give up his dream of playing pro hockey and commit himself fully to a career in the mortgage industry. He was suspended indefinitely by Wheeling but was later talked into returning to the ice by a former coach for his final pro season with the Trenton Titans in 2011-12. This black SP jersey from the first half of the season has an embroidery over twill Gladiator primary logo sewn on the front, along with the usual embroidered Kroger sponsor patch. An embroidered Gwinnett wordmark logo patch is sewn just below the neckline. Two alternate logo patches are sewn on the shoulders, as are the two color twill numbers and the black nameplate with single color letters. On the back hem the SP logo is embroidered to the jersey next to the sewn on ECHL embroidered logo, with the embroidered Meigray patch sewn on the opposite side. I acquired it from an eBay auction.
