

Gwinnett Gladiators Paul Flache 2011-12 game worn jersey, size 58.

Ontario native Paul Flache played three seasons in the OHL for Brampton before turning pro in 2002. He was assigned to the Greenville Grrrowl as a Thrashers prospect but the next season he joined Atlanta's new affiliate in Gwinnett for their inaugural campaign. He played 236 games over the course of five years in Gwinnett, serving as team captain during this, his final season, in 2011-12. After retirement from pro hockey, Flache remained in the Atlanta area working to develop young hockey players. This black SP jersey from the first half of the season has the embroidered Gladiator primary logo sewn on the front, along with the Kroger sponsor patch and the captain's C. An embroidered Gwinnett wordmark logo patch is sewn just below the neckline. Two embroidered alternate logo patches are sewn on each shoulder, as are the two color twill numbers and the black nameplate with single color letters. On the rear hem the SP logo is embroidered to the jersey next to the sewn on ECHL embroidered logo, and the embroidered Meigray patch sewn on the opposite side.
