

Gwinnett Gladiators Sean Duddy 2012-13 game worn jersey, size 54.

Michigan native Sean Duddy had only two pro seasons after graduating from Ohio State University. Duddy only appeared in a total of eighteen regular season and four playoff games with the Gladiators before he was dealt to Trenton via Cincinnati in February 2013 as part of a three team trade. Following his retirement in 2013, Duddy enrolled in law school at the University of Pennsylvania. This white set 1 jersey by SP Apparel marks the first significant change to the Gladiators white jerseys since the team's inaugural season in 2003. The two color sewn twill numbers were changed from cardinal over gold to cardinal over black, and the player nameplate was also changed from sewn cardinal twill letters to black. This jersey also has the Gladiators 10th anniversary logo patch sewn to the left sleeve and the 25th anniversary ECHL logo sewn on the right sleeve. On the front is the Gladiators wordmark logo, the team logo and the Kroger sponsor patch, with the alternate logo patches on each shoulder. On the back are embroidered Meigray and ECHL patches and the SP logo. This jersey was purchased directly from Meigray.
