

Augusta Riverhawks J.D. Paugh Memorial Night authentic jersey, size 50.

On October 23, 2011 Richmond County Deputy Sheriff J.D. Paugh was killed in the line of duty. The Augusta Riverhawks held a special benefit on December 17, 2011 in Paugh's memory and raised over \$10,000 for a college fund for Paugh's son Brandon. The players wore these custom white jerseys by OT Sports that night and they were auctioned off following the game. The jersey has sublimated logos that include the Riverhawks logo superimposed over a police badge on the front, an American flag on the top right, Paugh's radio call sign (T-31) over badges with crossed sticks on each shoulder, and stars on the bottom hem and sleeves. On the rear hem, there are embroidered SPHL and OT Sports patches sewn in the left and right corners respectively. I obtained this jersey, and the two others described on subsequent pages of this document without a name or number, from eBay auctions in 2013 and 2014. I personalized these jerseys myself with sewn two color twill numbers and one color letters in honor of Deputy Paugh. The Riverhawks presented a similar jersey to Brandon Paugh on the night of the benefit.
