

Augusta Riverhawks Jason Pietrasiak 2012-13 game worn jersey, size 52.

Shrewsbury, Massachusetts native Jason Pietrasiak ended his four year college career at NCAA Div. III Johnson and Wales University ranked fourth on the school's all-time scoring list with 67 goals and 64 assists for 131 career points. His 67 career goals ranked him second on the school's all-time scoring list and he is one of only a handful of players to have appeared in 100 games in a Wildcat uniform. Pietrasiak made his professional debut with Augusta after the conclusion of the Wildcat's 2012-13 season, scoring just 1 goal with 2 assists in ten games. In 2013-14, Pietrasiak split time between the SPHL and FHL. This Riverhawks third season white jersey by OT Sports has the team's embroidered primary logo stitched to the front with two smaller embroidered Riverhawks wordmark logo patches sewn on each shoulder. An embroidered SPHL logo is sewn on at the base of the V neck. The numbers are two color twill and the rear hem has a large Doctor's Hospital sponsor patch consisting of a screened logo on white twill. The OT Sports logo patch also appears on the back hem. The cloth used for the nameplate does not match the jersey, but since Pietrasiak joined the team late in the season, it was likely created and sewn by an equipment manager. A professional would have used a zigzag stitch along the edge of these blue twill letters to prevent the fraying that is observed on these letters. At least one other player wore #11 prior to Pietrasiak's arrival. The jersey shows good game use with team repairs. I obtained this jersey from another collector.
