

**Macon Mayhem David Jacobson/Louie George 2015-16 game worn jersey, size 58G.**

David Jacobson made his professional debut with the Macon Mayhem after playing four seasons for St. Norbert College in his native Wisconsin. In 2013-14, Jacobson was named the NCHA Men's Conference Player of the Year, ranking first in goals against average (1.28), save percentage (.935) and wins (19). He managed to post his outstanding statistics while playing nearly every game for the Green Knights that season. After a mediocre 0-4 start with Macon, Jacobson was placed on waivers in December and was picked up by the Peoria Rivermen. As the backup for SPHL veteran goaltender Kyle Rank, Jacobson posted a 14-4 record with a 2.18 goals-against-average, helping Peoria to the best record in the SPHL. The jersey was re-cycled for emergency backup goaltender Louie George, who joined the Mayhem in February when Garrett Bartus was loaned to the Adirondack Thunder in the ECHL. This blue OT Sports jersey exhibits light wear. It has the embroidered Mayhem primary logo sewn on the front, with embroidered secondary logos on each shoulder. Screened Kroger and Marco's Pizza sponsor patches are sewn to the right and left shoulders respectively. A small embroidered SPHL logo patch is sewn into the neckline, and embroidered SPHL and OT Sports logo patches are sewn to the rear hem. Two color twill numbers are sewn on the back and sleeves. The contrasting nameplate has heat pressed letters rather than the customary sewn twill letters. The secondary logo is also printed onto the white striped areas on the sleeves and hem. I obtained this jersey directly from the team.
