

**Columbus Cottonmouths Tom Fitzpatrick 2012-13 game worn jersey, size 56.**

The 2012-13 season was Fitzpatrick's first pro season after eleven seasons in junior and collegiate hockey. Fitzpatrick split the season with Columbus and two teams in the ECHL, the South Carolina Stingrays and the Ontario Reign. The front of this white home OT Sports jersey has embroidered sewn on letters and snake head logo along with a sewn on embroidered Hughston Clinic sponsor patch. The neck has a sewn on embroidered SPHL logo patch and the back and sleeves have sewn on two color twill numbers. On the left shoulder is a sewn on embroidered 2011-12 SPHL champions patch, commemorating the Snakes winning the President's Cup the previous season. On the right sleeve is a sewn on embroidered alternate logo patch. On the back is a sewn on screened Sunshine Banners & Signs sponsor patch and a cloth nameplate with the players name in single color sewn twill. The edges of this nameplate were sewn with a straight stitch as opposed to a zig zag, exposing the edges to fraying. In addition, the nameplate is not straight which leads me to believe it was added to the jersey by the team trainer as opposed to a professional seamstress, possibly after Fitzpatrick returned to Columbus after being released by the ECHL Ontario Reign. I purchased this directly from the team.
